

## *I Don't Feel No Ways Tired*

*Hebrews 10:35-38*

**<sup>35</sup> Do not let this happy trust in the Lord die away, no matter what happens. Remember your reward! <sup>36</sup> You need to keep on patiently doing God's will if you want him to do for you all that he has promised. <sup>37</sup> His coming will not be delayed much longer. <sup>38</sup> And those whose faith has made them good in God's sight must live by faith, trusting him in everything. Otherwise, if they shrink back, God will have no pleasure in them. <sup>39</sup> But we have never turned our backs on God and sealed our fate. No, our faith in him assures our souls' salvation.**

*Giving Honor to God the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit. To All of God's Sons, Daughters, and Children. Praise God from Whom All Blessings Flow at Big Bethel Nation. Turn to Hebrews 10:35-38 as we lift up the Name of the Lord. The sermon topic is "I Don't Feel No Ways Tired."*

*Good morning Saints. As we open up Hebrews 10:35-38, I'm reminded of the story of the Israelites in Exodus, Chapters 5 and 6. When ordered to let the Israelites go free, Pharaoh made their lives even more miserable. It seems that from that day forward, the Egyptians didn't supply the straw they (Israelites) needed to make bricks. The Israelites hoped and prayed for deliverance; instead, their bondage got worse. You may be working on a new project on the job, only to discover that there is a steep learning curve that makes the task of the project and your ability to function on the job much harder. Or you may have been praying for a financial blessing, only to be hit with another bill or you experience another financial short fall. You may have been praying for that pain in your body to go away, but you feel like your pain just won't go away. You may feel that you are stuck in the rut of life's trials and tribulations, and when you try to go forward, it seems that you're not getting anywhere. Well, the Lord sent me with a Word to encourage you. I'd like to share 3 points and then I'll take my seat.*

- 1. Be Patient.*
- 2. Trust in the Lord*

3. *He will never leave you.*

*Firstly, Be Patient. Romans 12:12 teaches us to be glad for all God is planning for you. Be patient in trouble, and prayerful always. My brothers and sister's patience is a good virtue. In fact, Isaiah 40:28-31 says, "Have you not known? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable. <sup>29</sup> He gives power to the faint, and strengthens the powerless. <sup>30</sup> Even youths will faint and be weary, and the young will fall exhausted; <sup>31</sup> but those who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint. We've got to give God time and space to work out the situation or circumstance for us. He will bring good results as we earnestly exercise patience in the Lord.*

*Secondly, Trust in the Lord. Proverbs 3:5-6 teaches us to <sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. Trust in the One who is able to do all things. It's important to realize that our insight can have some limitations. But God. O my goodness. But God... He is All knowing and See's everything. There is no limit to His Vision. And Who can deliver like our God? Nobody.*

I trust Him to heal my mind, body, and spirit.

I trust Him to supply All of my needs according to His riches in Glory.

I trust Him to put food on the table.

I trust Him to keep clothes on my back.

O' I trust Him to be my doctor in the sick room. I trust Him to provide for the family. I trust Him to make a way out of No Way.

I trust in the Lord to do the "Miraculous". O' I trust Him to Bless Big Bethel Nation in a Special Way.

Won't He do it. Say Yes, Say Yes, Say Yes. I know He will. His name is

J-E-S-U-S. He is Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God. Hallelujah.

Thirdly, **He will never leave you.** Matthew 28 verse 19-20 teach us to <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of

the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

We have a charge to keep, a God to Glorify, A never dying soul to save, and fit it for the sky. We share the Gospel Message of Jesus Christ and strive to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We share in teaching others to obey all that the Lord has commanded.

1 John 1:8 teach us that, “If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.” Now we know that the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is Eternal Life. (Romans 6:23).

The Lord says remember, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

*Somehow, Someway, in the midst of shortcomings, sin, brokenness, doubts, and areas where you and I have missed the mark, come up short, and just plain messed up. It's comforting to know that the Lord is still right there with you and with me. Because of the Love of the Lord, we can run on and see what the end is going to be. We are not tired..... No Ways. Let's Get Up and Tell Somebody about the Goodness of Jesus Christ; our Lord and Savior.*

*In closing, I remember Rev. James Cleveland's lyrics from an empowering spiritual selection. I don't feel no ways tired, I've come too far from where I started from. Nobody told me that the road would be easy, but I don't believe He brought me this far to leave me.*

Romans 10:9 shares that if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

#### ***Closing Prayer of Salvation***

***Lord I stand on your Holy Word and according to Romans 10:9. I confess with my mouth and believe in my heart that God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. I believe this and I receive Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior. Now, your name is written in the Lamb's book of life. (God Bless You and Heaven Smile Upon You. Welcome to the Body of Christ.)***
