

God is My Everything

The Temptation of Jesus

Luke 4:1-8 (KJV)

⁴ And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, ² Being forty days tempted of the devil. And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered. ³ And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread. ⁴ And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God. ⁵ And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. ⁶ And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. ⁷ If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine. ⁸ And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Giving Honor to God the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit. To All of God's Sons, Daughters, and Children. Praise God from Whom All Blessings Flow. Let's turn to Luke 4:1-8, as we lift up the Name of the Lord. Our topic today is "God is My Everything."

My God is the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. There is nothing too hard for Him. There is nothing He cannot handle. Because we know who we are in Christ Jesus and what we mean to our heavenly father; the enemy tries to discourage us. He tries to use sickness, financial hardship, family stress, and anything and everything you can think of to incapacitate us. The questions you must ask yourselves are, "Who is my God? Whom do I serve? Then, answer the question, "Is God a Way-Maker?" In Romans 8:31, The Bible says that if God be for us, who can be against Us?

God is so real in my soul (inner most parts of us). He has not only washed away all of my sins, but he has filled my cup with His love

so that my cup, runs, spills, and flows over. He is the lover of my soul; He is the Answer to my every need; He is my Burden-Bearer. Maybe you are the kind of person who can handle everything that comes your way, but I can't. I'm just like King David in this regard. *When My Heart is Overwhelmed, lead me to the Rock that is Higher than I. Jesus said come unto me all that are weak and heavy laden and I will give you rest. O' Yes, I know a man who is able to do exceedingly and abundantly above all that we can ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us... And his name is Jesus the Christ.*

The enemy fights those who know who they are and whose they are. The bible affirms that God is faithful (1 Cor. 1:9). The Word of God states in 1 Cor. 8:6, "But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him." Big Bethel, it's through God's blessings that we will pay off the mortgage of the church, pave the parking lot, and launch ministries, and sustain our current ministries. I thank God for the power of His Word. We have stuck together in the Lord. ***Hebrews 10:25, teach "Let us not forsake the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but let us exhort one another, especially as you see the Day approaching."***

Are you aware that the more the enemy fights you, the greater the indication that blessings are on the way? You must be cognizant of this fact as a Faith Filled Believer. If you do not know that about life, you cannot make it. You have got to know that it is because you are on the verge of a miracle that the devil is fighting you. He is fighting you so hard because you are getting closer to your deliverance; and the closer you get, the greater your struggle. Beloved, we must continue to pray for one another, we

must continue to exhort one another in the Lord Jesus Christ.

If you hold out a little while longer (don't give into temptation), God's going to give you the victory in every circumstance of your life. Beloved, be encouraged when you meet with obstacles because you can view them as an indication of a fresh move of God, the fresh move of Jesus Christ, and the fresh move of the Holy Spirit in your life. Hallelujah, to the Lamb of God. We all ought to enjoy the fellowship in the Lord in our lives.

When people ask you who your God is, how do you respond? With confidence, your shoulders held high, and a smile on your face, you can say, "He is My Everything. He is my Father, the Creator of the Heavens and the Earth and the One who sustains the Universe. He is Jehovah, and the I Am that I Am. I know Him as a Strong Tower, the Doctor in the Sick Room, My Lawyer in the Court Room.

In closing, the Lord is available to you today. Won't you come? Romans 10:9-11 says that if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. God is My Everything! He put money in my pocket. Clothes on my back. God is... My Everything!

God is My Everything! He's my joy in sorrow. He's my hope for tomorrow. He's my rock in a weary land. My shelter in the time of storm. God is... God is... God is... My Everything!!! Amen.
