

He's Able

Psalms 145:13-17 (KJV): Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations. ¹⁴The Lord upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down. ¹⁵The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season. ¹⁶Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing. ¹⁷The Lord is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.

Giving honor to God, Jesus the Christ, and the Holy Spirit. Giving honor to the men, women, and children of God. To my fellow brothers and sisters in Christ. As we look at today's text of Psalms 145:13-17, I would like to share from the topic "He's Able."

As I rise this morning and reflect on the beauty of Psalms, I am reminded of how an unknown Psalmist shared that even though his spirit grew weak, God continued to watch over him (Psalm 142:3), because God is Able. My brothers and sisters, did you think about God's Eyes watching over you this morning? No matter where you are in life and where life is in you, God has continued to watch over you. Good God Almighty.

While you slept and while I slept our God counted it not robbery to keep the death angel away and watched over us all night long and was with us early this morning. I just believe "He's Able." In fact, God's kingdom has no end. In Psalms 145:13 the writer shares that His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom and that His dominion or His rule, love, and sovereignty endures throughout all generations. Our God is in the blessing business. He blessed Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. He blessed our great grandparents, our grandparents, our mothers and fathers, our children, grandchildren, and He is blessing us right now. Can somebody testify that "He's Able."

My brothers and sisters, we know **He's Able** and that's why we wait on the lord. Has anybody been waiting on the Lord? Isaiah 40:31 says "But those that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint." The scripture also teaches us, that the Lord provides. (Psalm 145:15) He gives us meat in due season. In this context meat is representative of blessing which supplies our need (s), which may be spiritual, financial, physical, etc. He's Able. God knows how to bless, and His

timing is perfect. Historically, in the world of agriculture, there are some crops that could be ruined if they came up out of season. Isn't it a blessing that God knows how, when, where, and how much to bless us with.

Beloved, God simply opens his hand and pours out blessings on all creation or on every living thing. The psalmist speaks to the righteousness of our God and His holiness in all things. (Psalm 145:16-17) Hallelujah, to the lamb of God.

I came to remind you that our **God is Able**. Even if you've been struggling for a year, a month, a week, or a few days. **He's Able**. If you've become weary and discouraged, don't you dare stop trusting God, who has been watching over you, putting food on the table, clothes on your backs, and has truly been Able to supply all of our needs according to His riches in glory. Just know and understand that Yes, **He's Able**. When it seems like you're too fatigued to get over the hump or persevere, God has the miraculous ability to bless you in the midst of the situation or circumstance. **God is Able** to pick you up when you're down, God is Able to turn your life around. **God is Able**. He's more for you than the whole world against you. **God is Able**. Even when it seems like your feet are stumbling, **God is Able**. I'm so thankful that God can pick you and I back up again. Why? Because... The Lord upholds all that fall, and raises up all those who are bowed down. **He is Able**.

I'm coming on in now. I see a landing strip. If you find that you're out of the ark of safety, come on into the family of Jesus Christ today. Romans 10:9-10, teaches us "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. In Acts 2:38 Peter said, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen. (Jude 24-25).
