

## Make the Vision Plain

**Habakkuk 2:2 (KJV) -<sup>2</sup> And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.**

Giving Honor to God the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit. To All of God's Sons, Daughters, and Children. Praise God from Whom All Blessings Flow. Let's turn to Habakkuk 2:2, as we lift up the Name of the Lord. Our topic is "Make the Vision Plain"

When you reflect on your life, have you ever experienced a series of setbacks, delays, or lack luster moments? Have you ever felt like you were underperforming, and it seemed like you just couldn't make it over the top to your desired level of success? If you've experienced the aforementioned obstacles, I want to direct your heart to the Word of God and remind you that the Lord is Able to Deliver You. YES, God has a plan for your life. Believe in your vision, write the vision down, and make it plain.

**God's Plan for You.** "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end." (Jeremiah 29:11) God is already working it out for your good. He woke you up today because He has a divine plan for your life. Get Up – Get Going because you are fearfully and wonderfully made. You are somebody special. You are made in the image of God. I wish you could see you. David said, "Lord, how I love you!.For you have done great things for me. In my distress I screamed to the Lord for his help. And He heard me from heaven; my cry reached His ears. (Psalms 18:6) When is the last time you told God all about your pain, fears, brokenness, and shortcomings? Pause for a moment – ***Make the Vision Plain.***

**Write It Down.** When you write down the vision (the plan) that the Lord has for your life, it keeps you on track. It simplifies your tasks so that you can focus on the Lord with Peace and mitigate distractions. The scripture says, I will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee, because he trusts in thee. (Isa.26:3) Statistically, it allows you to implement short term plans because you understand that there are different seasons, but you can count on the Lord Jesus to be right there with you, because He will never leave you or forsake you. ***Take a moment to write down who the Lord Jesus is...*** Then invite Him into every area of your life. Feeling sick in your body? When is the last time you told the Lord to come on in the room and heal your infirmity? You've been waiting on a promotion. When's the last time you wrote down the attributes of Christ that can grow in you, while you aspire to reach the next level. Whatever the Lord has purposed in your heart, you have to nourish that vision. You have to nourish that plan. You have to talk to the Lord about it. Then, you must ***Write it Down.*** By writing it down it will make your focus laser sharp and allow you to walk in the role and live the life that the Lord has called you to be in. Tell somebody – Write It Down and ***Make the Vision Plain.***

**Run on in Success.** Once you write the vision, and make it plain, then it's time to run on in success because you are implementing the task associated with God's divine plan for your life. How do we grow in the preparation of implementing the plan? Your prayer life, reading God's Word, devotion, and service. ***Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. (2 Tim. 2:15)*** Taking advantage of the opportunity to pray strengthens our relationship with God. Reading the Bible increases our understanding of the Lord and His statutes. Daily devotion strengthens our worship and allows us to commune with God. Our service builds our level of discipleship in the Lord. It's time to encourage yourself in the Lord and run on in success. You are the head and not the tail. You are above and not beneath. You are a child of the King. What the bible says you can have, you can have. What the bible says you can do, you can do. 'Cause you can do all things through Christ who strengthens you. Greater is He that is in you than he who is in the world. You can do all things through Christ, who is your strength. (Phil 4:13) Get Up, Stand Up, and tell the world – I'm going to run on and see what the end is going to be. Run on in success. Write it down. Yes... **Make the Vision Plain!!!**

In closing, make the vision plain. Yes, there will be storms in life and every now and then – obstacles in our way. The Apostle Paul found strength in realizing that God was in control. He said, "I have learned in every state I am, to be content." (Phil. 4:11) You can be content in knowing that the Lord is right there with you. In Jesus Christ there is a plan for your salvation. If you don't know Him in the pardon of your sins, this is what you need to do. According to Romans 10:8-11, ***For salvation that comes from trusting Christ—which is what we preach—is already within easy reach of each of us; in fact, it is as near as our own hearts and mouths. For if you tell others with your own mouth that Jesus Christ is your Lord and believe in your own heart that God has raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in his heart that a man becomes right with God; and with his mouth he tells others of his faith, confirming his salvation.*** Yes, God has a plan for you. Write it down. Make it Plain. Run on in Success. ***In Jesus Name.*** Amen.
