Isaiah 43:1-2 (KJV) But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine. ² When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.

When you go through the water, He will be right there. When you go through the floods of life, He'll be right there. He's more for you than the whole world against you. He's there all the time.

God is Our Refuge and Strength

I want you to know that the obstacles in your life are only temporary, while the God you serve is eternal. You see God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. (Psalm 46:1-2) Have you ever been in trouble? If the answer is yes, then I want you to understand that there is help and it's on the way because the Lord is our refuge. The term refuge means a condition of being safe or sheltered from pursuit, danger, or trouble. I wish I had time to teach it today, but when we look back over our lives, everyone of us can testify that when we were in trouble, when we were being pursued by the enemy, when we were in imminent danger, when we were in big trouble – our God heard our desperate cry. I just believe that every now and then, we all need to have a little talk with Jesus, and tell him about all of our troubles. He'll hear our faintest cry, and answer by and by. Now when you feel a little prayer wheel turning, you'll know a little fire's burning. Just a little talk with Jesus makes it right. God is your refuge and strength, an ever present help in times of trouble. He's There All the Time.

You're Never Alone

You are the temple of God and His presence is inside of you. 1 Corinthians 3:16 says "Don't you know that you yourselves are the temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you." The psalmist said "Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? If I ascend up into Heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me."
