

## He'll Do It Again

**Psalm 75:6-7 (KJV) For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another".**

*Giving Honor to God the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit. To All of God's Sons, Daughters, and Children. Turn to Psalm 75:6-7, as we lift up the Name of the Lord. The sermon topic is 'He'll do It Again.'*

**Recipe for Success** - In sharing the recipe of baking homemade biscuits, you will find that there are some essential items that you will need. You'd start with 2 cups all-purpose flour, 1 teaspoon of sugar, 1 tablespoon baking powder, 1 teaspoon salt, 8 tablespoons cubed butter, 3/4 cup (more or less if needed) of milk. Now you will need to preheat the oven to 425 °F. Get a large mixing bowl, then combine flour, sugar, baking powder and salt together. Cut the butter into the mixture until it begins to look like cornmeal. Be sure to mix it well with flour mixture and slowly add milk into the middle. Knead the dough with your fingers and add milk when necessary. Take your time and roll out the dough onto a lightly floured surface and roll out to desired thickness. Cut the dough with a small biscuit cutter and make sure you butter the bottom of the skillet and place biscuits in the pan. **Bake for 12 minutes or until golden brown.** This is a recipe for success as you make delicious biscuits.

What if I shared with you that there is a recipe for success? Yes, my brothers and sisters there is a recipe or a process for success in your life, and it's right there in the Word of God. Be careful not to substitute anything. Substitutes or changes could result in an array of unpredictable results, especially during the baking process. You know... when the **heat** is turned up! We'd like for the dough to be promoted to delicious biscuits. In our lives, promotion doesn't come from the east, west, north or south. God is the judge and He is able to elevate and promote you to the next level. **Whatever your *IT* is... turn it over to God and let the Lord bless you by doing HIS "IT" (blessing) again, as you embrace the following:**

**Trust in the LORD** with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. (Proverbs 3:5-6). Trusting in God means to rely on Him totally. It's a blessing to trust God with your mind, will, emotions during the good times, difficult times, sunny days, and rainy days. Trust Him when everything is calm and peaceful. Trust Him when the storms of life are raging, but with a clear understanding that trust goes beyond our intellectual capacity. Our God is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we can ask or think, according to His riches in glory.

**Surround yourself with like minded people.** There is power in unity. There are times in your life when everything might not feel good. There are times when you may feel

less than, ashamed, disappointed or ostracized. You may be going through a storm or a difficult season. My brothers and sisters there are times when you need to hear the testimony of others and how God made a way and delivered them out of their situation. Hallelujah, their testimony will encourage you. "Let us **not** neglect meeting together, as some have made a habit, but let us encourage one another, and all the more as you see the Day approaching." (Hebrews 10:25) Surround yourself with like minded people. People who love the Lord and care for you. Their testimony will help you understand that God has no respect of persons. The songwriter said "You may not know how, you may not know when;but He'll do it again." In our culture, we call this community. I don't know about you, but during my toughest trials in life God has always blessed me with people who celebrated my accomplishments with me, but also sent the same people to minister to me when I felt down. Can I get a witness? God will send you the brothers and sisters that will pray for you, encourage you, minister to you, and celebrate your promotions with you. Yes. You can celebrate and they can celebrate knowing that the promotion was a part of the process. And guess what? The process is the recipe for success. "He'll Do It Again."

***The Law of Attraction*** means that you attract like minded people. One may say, "I want a prayer warrior in my life". Then you need to start being a prayer warrior and spend more time in prayer, bible study, and devotion. One may say, "I want a financially minded person in my life". Start spending more time increasing your financial literacy and sow some seed, so your harvest will be plentiful. One may say, "I want the gift of healing." Start spending more time understanding the human condition (mind, body, and spirit). Spend more time visiting the sick. This will help you, to not only receive the gift, but a readiness to practice and operate in the gift (s) to the glory of God. The promotion is on the way. Walk in faith and believe it to happen. Follow the process and remember there is a recipe. God is faithful. Hasn't He Always come through for you? **Yes, He has and He'll do it again.**

In conclusion, all have sinned and come short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23) Stay the course and know that God is able. The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ, our Lord. (Romans 6:23) Trust in the Lord, surround yourself with like-minded believers, and you will attract like-minded people. Yes, my brothers and sisters... there is a recipe (process) for success in your life. His name is Jesus!!! Don't substitute sugar for flour or orange juice for milk. Don't substitute anything. Follow the recipe. He (Jesus) has done it before and He'll do it again. ***He'll do it again (Oh He'll do it again). He'll do it again (Yes He will do it again). If you'll just take a look at where you are now and where you've been. Hasn't He always come through for you? He's the same now as then. You may not know how. You may not know when. But He'll do it again.*** Promotion doesn't come from the east, west,north, or south. God is the judge and He is able to elevate and promote you to the next level. Open your heart

and invite Jesus to be your Lord and Savior today. The bible says “Everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved. You may not know how, you may not know when – **He’ll do it again**. Thank You Jesus. Hallelujah, Amen.
